

Lehigh Cement’s Fuel Surcharge:

The Fuel Surcharge (FSC) will be a calculated average of the retail diesel rate including taxes based in Vancouver. A retail rate is used because they are the most accessible and can be found at the [Kalibrate](https://www.kalibrate.com) website. The FSC will be calculated using the average of diesel prices from the 25th to the 25th of each month. With the rate taking effect on the first of the new month.

Example: the average diesel rate including taxes on the Kalibrate website from January 25th to February 24th was 180.7 so the FSC in March was \$1. For the month of April, it will be based on the average diesel rate from February 25th to March 24th and will take effect on April 1.

The below table outlines the per tonne FSC to the corresponding diesel rate:
